

Executive Airport and Franklin Field Master Plans

The Sacramento County Airport System is resuming the Airport Master Planning programs for Executive Airport and Franklin Field. The County is preparing for the future of our region, our communities and our airports with this effort.

These planning programs will continue and complete the planning process started in 2005 for each airport and will help to guide development of Executive Airport and Franklin Field over the next 20 years. Each plan will include the following elements:

- ✦ A **vision** set forth by the County, City and community, including airport users.
- ✦ An **inventory** of existing facilities, activity, and regional growth factors.
- ✦ **Forecasts** of airport activity including projected levels of aircraft operations and numbers and types of aircraft, etc.
- ✦ **Demand/capacity and facility requirements** for airfield, terminal, roadway, parking, hangars, other aviation-related uses, and non-aviation-related uses.
- ✦ Development and evaluation of **alternatives** that can provide the level of facilities needed to meet the projected demand.
- ✦ A **recommended development plan** based on the most favorable development option.
- ✦ An **environmental overview** identifying environmental issues and constraints that must be taken into consideration.
- ✦ A **capital improvement program** that projects capital costs and potential funding sources for implementation of the recommended airport improvements.
- ✦ A **public involvement** program that allows all interested parties to provide input to and obtain information from the master plan update process and status.
